

Petition for a private bill: called Estreats (Personal Representatives) Lancelot Webb bill, for reviving continuing and explaining several Laws therein mentioned [that] are expired and near expiring to prevent personal injuries better and to improve the health of Lancelot Junior Webb

SHEWETH:

That pursuant to the provisions of the Estreats (Personal Representatives) Act 1692 (1692 CHAPTER 24 4 Will and Mar), there exists a necessity to revive, continue, and explain several laws therein mentioned that are expired or nearing expiration, in order to better prevent personal injuries and improve the health of Lancelot Junior Webb, a parishioner whose welfare urgently requires the proposed measures.

WHEREAS the legislative framework established under the Act of 1692 provides for the implementation of measures to ensure equitable enforcement and sustenance of rights and obligations, which have fallen into disuse or insufficient applicability to address modern exigencies;

WHEREAS Lancelot Junior Webb has been subject to personal injuries and circumstances of diminished health, which may be alleviated or remedied through the reactivation and adaptation of said laws to contemporary standards;

WHEREAS the continuation and clarification of these statutes would further serve the public interest by ensuring broader protections against harm and fostering public health standards;

WHEREFORE, your petitioner prays that your Honourable House may be pleased to enact a private bill, hereinafter to be referred to as the "Estreats (Personal Representatives) Lancelot Webb Bill," which shall:

Revive and continue the laws referenced under the Estreats (Personal Representatives) Act 1692, with necessary modifications to render them applicable to present-day needs and circumstances.

Establish specific provisions within said revived laws aimed at preventing personal injuries, including but not limited to, enhanced safety regulations, enforcement measures, and legal remedies.

Include measures to improve the health and welfare of Lancelot Junior Webb by instituting appropriate public health programs, access to necessary medical care, and supportive community interventions.

Ensure that the revived and clarified statutes maintain coherence with existing legal frameworks and do not conflict with other laws currently in force.
