

**Petition for a Private Bill: To provide HL Health Board CIC the power to maintain public order, safety, and health in towns.**

**To the Honourable Members of the House of Commons and the House of Lords,**

That the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 was enacted to provide a framework for maintaining public order, safety, and health within towns, addressing issues of nuisance, sanitation, and public welfare.

That there exists a pressing need to incorporate the purposes and provisions still in force under the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 into the functions and objectives of HL Health Board CIC to further enhance public health, safety, and welfare in all parishes of England and Wales.

That your Petitioner proposes the application of the said Act to the operations of HL Health Board CIC, a Community Interest Company (CIC), to strengthen its mandate as a local board of health serving the Windrush Generation, Black, Asian, and Minority Ethnic (BAME) communities, and other residents in England and Wales.

That HL Health Board CIC will undertake the following objectives in alignment with the purposes of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847:

- a. Enforcing provisions related to public nuisances, sanitation, and the removal of obstructions in public places to protect community health.
- b. Collaborating with local authorities and law enforcement to ensure public order and safety in alignment with the Act's objectives.
- c. Promoting public health education and initiatives to mitigate the spread of disease and improve sanitation standards.
- d. Facilitating the maintenance of safe and accessible streets, marketplaces, and communal areas as outlined under the Act.
- e. Ensuring equitable application of these provisions to meet the specific needs of the Windrush Generation and BAME communities.

That incorporating the provisions of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 into the operational framework of HL Health Board CIC will enhance its ability to safeguard public health and welfare while addressing systemic challenges faced by underserved populations.

That the establishment of HL Health Board CIC with these additional powers will contribute significantly to reducing health disparities, improving living conditions, and fostering safer and healthier communities.

That your Petitioner has consulted with local residents, authorities, and stakeholders, all of whom support the application of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 to HL Health Board CIC.

Wherefore your Petitioner humbly prays that your Honourable House will:

Grant leave to bring in a Private Bill to apply the purposes and provisions still in force under the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 to the operations of HL Health Board CIC, ensuring its effectiveness as a local board of health in all parishes of England and Wales.

Provide for such powers, duties, and provisions as may be necessary to support the objectives and functions of HL Health Board CIC under the said Act.

And your Petitioner, as in duty bound, will ever pray.
